Cost of Contacts Not Included

Please bring your contact lenses and prescription on the day of exam

New Patient or Has Never Worn Contacts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spherical/toric contacts• Multifocal contacts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• \$200• \$300
Established Patient (Has had a contact lens exam here before and wears contacts currently)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Annual contact lens exam- renew current prescription• Wears soft contacts and needs or desires to change lens type. A contact lens fitting includes:

- ⇒ Evaluation, fitting, and contact lens prescription by the doctor
- ⇒ Contact lens training and handling for first time wearers
- ⇒ If contact lens fitting is not successful, physician fees will still apply
- ⇒ If an additional visit is needed after one month, a fitting fee of **\$75** will apply

Ordering contact lenses:

- ⇒ You may order contacts through our office or we can give you your prescription to order elsewhere.
- ⇒ Contact lens companies require an exam once a year in order to dispense contacts. Please schedule accordingly before running out of contacts!

Our Policy: The contact lens evaluation is a stand-alone service. It is separate from the patient exam, testing and/or refraction (which is also a non-covered service) and we do not submit to your health insurance. The fee is collected in addition to any copay/ deductible that is due for the eye exam without contact lenses.
