Creating an Order Set for Outgoing Referrals



- Purpose: Creating an order set for outgoing referrals allows the user to select specialists/physicians that are commonly used in the orders and procedure section of the EMR Note.
- Order Set: Users can create a new Order Set or Outgoing Referral List by going to Administration>Order Tracking Setup>Order Set




Adding a Panel: Under Order Set select 'Add Panel' to create a new panel:



Add to CPT Superbill: Once you have set up the outgoing referral you can add this to the superbill by going to Administration>EMR Setup>CPT Superbill:



Scroll down to the "Referral" Category* and select 'Add Item'.



- Enter the **Item Name** of the referral you had created under order set
 In this example 'Otolaryngology'. It will then be made available in the drop down list.
- You can then leave the default description, or elaborate upon it.
- Then 'Save' your new Referral.






• Once you have set up the outgoing referral in the superbill you can now use the referral in your note. Referrals will be seen under **EMR Note>Orders & Procedures**:

Tracking an Outgoing Referral: Once the outgoing referral is created the referral can then be tracked:

*Adding a Category to Superbill: If you do not already have a 'Referral' category in your superbill go to Administration>EMR Setup>Superbill Categories:
