Re: System Update to Waiting Room Solutions

The WRS Development Team completed a software update to the Waiting Room Solutions System on February 13, 2010. The updated version of the system includes the following enhancements and added functionality. These have been designed to improve overall system functionality, security and usability. This update includes the following:

Support for National Drug Codes (NDC) CMS 1500

Functionality to add National Drug Codes (NDC) has now been added to transfer these codes from the EMR Note to the CMS 1500 Claim Form.

- **Medications>Administer Medication**

Administer Medication has been added to the Medication section of all notes. When a medication is added to the note, the option to **Administer Medication** appears:

At the bottom of the dialog, there are four buttons: "Add as Prescription", "Add as Current Medication", "Administer Medication", and "Dispense Sample". A yellow arrow points to the "Administer Medication" button.

When this button is pressed the **Medication Administration** box opens. Default NDC and HCPC (J Code) values for the selected medication are displayed as identified from the FDA Drug Database. The practice can then fill out any additional items on the administration of the medication. Pressing **Save & Close** will add this medication to the **Current Medications** section of the note. These codes are automatically carried to the CMS 1500 Claim.

Note that if a HCPC is entered directly on this screen and it has a corresponding NDC Code, a pop-up of mapped NDC code will appear and can be selected. In addition, the 2 digit unit of measure related to the code will appear, if applicable.

- **Orders & Procedures>NDC Codes**

When an identified CPT code is added to a note (i.e. injection) a corresponding NDC code, with pull-down list of alternate NDC codes, will be displayed. Selecting one of these codes, and pressing Continue, will add the NDC code to that visit.

- **CMS 1500>NDC Codes**

The codes entered from the medication area of any note will automatically populate the CMS 1500 claim form. In addition, NDC codes can be added directly to the CMS 1500 form in the shaded area of Box 24A. Clicking in the box and entering the code will trigger the system to look up the code. Box 24A entries will have the NDC qualifier "N4" followed immediately (no spaces) by the NDC code in the shaded area.

Each drug's 2 digit NDC unit of measure and numeric quantity administered to the patient must also be included in the shaded area of Box 24D for each line item. Note that there are four possible units of measure qualifiers that can be used (F2-International Unit, GR-Gram, ML-Milliliter or UN-unit). Reporting a fraction of a unit is done by using the decimal point. Nine numbers may precede the decimal and three numbers may follow the decimal.

Outgoing Referral Functionality

Functionality for creating Outgoing Referrals (Referral Orders) has been added to the system. Under the existing "Referral" Tab, practice users can now specify an Outgoing Referrals to another provider and a date/time stamp of the referral will be displayed.

Outgoing Referral information can include the Date, Provider Name, Address/Phone, Specialty, Reason for Referral, and Referring Provider Name. Note that the existing "Referral" Tab has been relabeled as "Incoming Referrals" (from another provider). Functionality for Incoming Referrals has not been changed.
