Re: WRS Health System Update

The WRS Development Team will be performing an update on or about February 14, 2014. This release will include the following functionality as required for Meaningful Use Stage 2 (MU2):

Updated ERx Messages

ERx Messaging has been updated for MU2 standards. Validation of prescription data now requires increased screening and prescribers may encounter errors that were not presented in previous prescribing functionality. Within new requirements, prescriptions cannot be routed without NDC/Quantity/Refill/Sig and valid patient address information on file.

If the prescription contains missing or invalid information the user will be presented with an error message that identifies item(s) to be corrected. The user should then enter all requested data and resubmit the prescription. Note that the prescription must be resubmitted after errors are addressed in order to successfully transmit the prescription.

Patient Educational Materials

Functionality has been added to address MU2 Patient Education Requirements. Educational Links now appear as green “E” icons. These have been added to the following EMR pages: Medications, Assessment & Plan, Orders & Procedures, View Test Results and Order Tracking (All Tests, Ordered, Completed, Closed, Requiring Action).

Clicking on the green “E” will present educational content as related to the diagnosis, order or medication entered:

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Ear Disorders

Your ear has three main parts: outer, middle and inner. You use all of them in hearing. Sound waves come in through your outer ear. They reach your middle ear, where they make your eardrum vibrate. The vibrations are transmitted through three tiny bones, called ossicles, in your middle ear. The vibrations travel to your inner ear, a snail-shaped organ. The inner ear makes the nerve impulses that are sent to the brain. Your brain recognizes them as sounds. The inner ear also controls balance.

A variety of conditions may affect your hearing or [balance](#):

- [Ear infections](#) are the most common illness in infants and young children.
- [Tinnitus](#), a roaring in your ears, can be the result of loud noises, medicines or a variety of other causes.

POPULATION OF LOCATION

Logic has been added to detect the location where a service is performed, as taken from location of the appointment, note signing or selected User Login. This information will auto-populate **Service Facility Location CMS 1500 Box 32** when a claim is generated. The order of **Service Facility Location** is as follows:

Determination of Service Facility (CMS 1500 - Box 32)	
(1) Appointment Location (default)	If no appointment exists... step (2)
(2) Location of User at Note Creation	If the note is not created... step (3)
(3) User Location selected at WRS Login	If items (1) and (2) are not applicable and a new claim is created. Also, for all notes created prior to this update (Notes created before 02/15/14)
