Re: System Update to Waiting Room Solutions

The WRS Development Team will be performing a software update to the Waiting Room Solutions System on or about October 22, 2010. The updated system will include the following enhancements and functionality. These have been designed to improve overall system functionality, security and usability. This release includes:

Permissions Settings for Practice Logs

Additional settings have been added to the User Permission settings to allow/disallow access to Practice Clinical Logs, Security Logs, Emergency Access Logs and System Settings. Permissions can be adjusted for any user by clicking on the Resource Name (User Name) and selecting the Permissions tab. Press Save, once this selection is completed, to make changes effective:

Authorized User Configuration Message

Functionality has from been added to allow the configuration of a default message to be presented on the Select Location screen appearing during the user log-in process. This message can be customized under **Administration->Practice Setup->Edit Privacy Policy:**




Figure 3: Select Location Screen>Authorized Access Message (User Log-In)

Weight-based Alert for Medication Dosage

Alerts for prescribing certain medications outside of an accepted weight range have been added. The system will alert the user if the dosage is incorrect, based on patient age or BSA:
