ADHD:

Attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) is a common chronic illness in children marked by an ongoing pattern of inattention and/or hyperactivity-impulsivity that interferes with functioning or development. Most children go through times when their behavior is off from its normalcy, they can have issues paying attention, become distracted, and be in constant motion. For some children though this becomes an everyday occurrence at home and school that starts to interfere with their ability to live a normal life.

At Surf Pediatrics and Medicine, we have an ADHD program to help these children. Below are our offices guidelines for managing ADHD.
